(1) Welcome and Announcements

The meeting commenced at 3pm.

The passing of Michael Schaper who made an excellent contribution to the key meeting in Anaheim was recorded with condolences to his family and colleagues.

The purpose of this meeting was to finalize the new ICF-WASI Website. The authority for creating this website derives from the ICF ExCo Meeting in Anaheim, May 19, 2011, USA and the new Bye-Laws - appended held at the ICF-ASTM Interquadrennial. The report of the VHCF5 ICF Interquadrennial (Berlin, Germany, June 2011) is also appended. Also announced was the success of the ICF Interquadrennial in Luxor in November 2011 - report appended. A number of MoUs have been signed or are in process since Anaheim: Portugal, France, Egypt, Libya, Spain, Nigeria, India - Portugal MoU appended as an exemplar.

(2) ICF-WASI Website

Francesco Iacoviello reported comprehensively on the digitizing and uploading of the ICF proceedings and the structuring of the new website [www.icf-wasi.org](http://www.icf-wasi.org) via "BitForm". All points of the "ICF Website Presentation Draft" (appended) were discussed and agreed. It was noted that in the Proceedings section the search engine was incompletely operating and required substantial improvement. The formal launch will be in Autumn 2012 in connection with an IGF event in Torino and publicized via the ICF ExCo and Council Members as well as the MoU Associations and via a Newsletter to the ICF-WASI community.
